


Important Safety Instructions




Please read all instructions carefully before use.



Cat or kitten must weigh at least 2.2lbs (1kg) and is aged 6 months or older to safely use the device.



DO NOT place the device on carpet. Place it on a sturdy and flat floor and leave some space around it.



DO NOT drag the device. To avoid damaging the weighing sensor, please lift the base when moving it.



DO NOT rinse or immerse the base in water or other liquid.

1. This device is not intended to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction by person responsible for their safety.
2. Children under 6-year-old are not allowed to play with this device to avoid unpredictable risks.
3. Please use this device only for intended household purposes as described in this User Manual.
4. This device only supports 2.4G Wi-Fi. 5G Wi-Fi is not supported.

Important Safety Instructions

ELECTRICITY SAFETY

1. DO NOT use the device if it has a damaged power cord or plug, or if it is malfunctioning or has been damaged.
2. This device is only powered by the original adapter included in the package box.
3. DO NOT immerse the power adapter in water or other liquid.
4. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its authorized distributor, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid unpredictable hazard.
5. Please unplug the device when not in use, before installing and removing its parts, and before cleaning, maintenance or repair it.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE


1. Place the litter mat in front of the device. Do not place the mat partially or completely under the device.
2. For indoor use only. Do not use this device in a high temperature and high humidity environment.
3. DO NOT sit on or place anything on top of the litter box.
4. DO NOT put anything in the device other than clumping litters that are small enough to pass through the sieve.
5. DO NOT allow cats to bite, chew on or swallow any parts, especially the power cord.
6. DO NOT open the cover lid while the litter box is rotating.
7. DO NOT attempt to disassemble, repair, modify or replace any part of the device privately. Any repair or maintenance must be performed by qualified personnel only.
8. DO NOT put foreign objects in the inner bin.
9. Dispose of all packaging materials properly. Keep away from children and pets.
10. Please wash your hands thoroughly after removing the waste. Those who are pregnant or with suppressed immune systems should note that a parasite sometimes found in the cat waste could cause toxoplasmosis. Please be cautious or consult with a physician before cleaning the waste.
11. It is recommended to replace the waste bag every 3 to 5 days to avoid bacteria growth.





Production Installation




Make sure that the cover lid and waste drawer are properly installed in place before power on the device.





Place the device on a sturdy and flat floor, and leave some space around it. Do not cling to any walls.





Place the mat in front of the litter box.





Slide out the waste drawer from either side.





Remove the fix frame. Put a waste bag evenly inside and flatten all edges.





Put the deodorizer into the deodorizer holder. Insert the frame back with the holder on the correct side.

Slide the waste drawer back in place. You will hear a "beep" when the waste drawer is properly installed (if already connected to power).



Power on the device and the bin will automatically rotate a full circle. Wait for it when rotation is completed.

* The device will automatically enter into pairing mode (indicator flashing in green) if it is used for the first time. Pair with your mobile as instructed in Wi-Fi Setup or use with button only.

Add clumping litter up to the MAX line. Wait for the bin to automatically spread out the litter for about 5 minutes.

* You can also press the button once to start cleaning to spread out the litter manually.

Tips to help your cat adapt to the new litter box:

Location is the key. Place the litter box in the same location as the old one, or leave the old one nearby for a short period of time. Do not throw the old device away until your cat adapts to the new device.

Use recognizable scents. Add a scoop of litter from the old device to the new one to make familiar scent for your cat.

Button and Indicator



Button Functions



Hold for 10s to bring into pairing mode or restore to factory settings.



Press once to start cleaning. If already started, press it once to pause.



Press twice to empty all litter. If already started, press it once or twice to pause.

Wi-Fi Setup



- 1 Make sure that your smart device is connected to a secure 2.4GHz network and Bluetooth is enabled. Allow access to your Location during connection.
- 2 Make sure that the bin is at the Home position before connecting.
- 3 You can use the litter box with control button only or download App for more customizable functions.
- 4 The litter box can only be linked to one account. You can hold the button for 10s to pair it with another device, share the device with your family members on App.

HOW TO REPLACE THE WASTE BAG




The frequency to replace the waste bag depends on the number and size of your cat(s). It is recommended to replace it every 3 to 5 days to avoid bacteria growth. Keep the waste bag away from children under 6-year-old.





Slide out the waste drawer from either side.





Remove the fix frame and take out the old waste bag.

Put a waste bag evenly inside and flatten all edges, and then insert the frame back with the deodorizer holder on the correct side.


Slide the waste drawer back in place. You will hear a "beep" when the waste drawer is properly installed (if already connected to power).

Cleaning and Maintenance

EMPTYING AND CLEANING




- Make sure the waste drawer is empty before dumping **all** litter.
- The frequency to clean the device depends on your personal preference and your cat's behavior. It is recommended to clean the inner bin every one to three months.
- Dry **all** parts thoroughly before installing them back in place for future use.





Slide out the waste drawer and dispose of the litter. Replace with a new waste bag and slide the waste drawer back.





Press the button twice to start emptying all litter.


Wait until the empty cycle is done (bin stops rotating). Slide out the waste drawer and dispose of the litter.


Unplug the litter box. Remove the cover lid and hold to take out the bin.



Rinse the bin, cover lid, waste bin and litter mat. Air dry thoroughly before reassembling.





Clean the base with a soft and slight damp cloth or by wipes. DO NOT rinse or immerse in water.

Place the bin back on the base, making sure that the bin handle is upward.

Align and place the cover lid back, making sure that the cover lid properly installed on the base.

PROBLEM

SOLUTION

Fail to connect the litter box.

- Check if your mobile is connected to a secure 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network and Bluetooth is enabled. Allow access to your Location during connection.
- Check if your mobile and litter box are connected to the same Wi-Fi network.
- Check if you input a correct Wi-Fi password and the litter box is under strong Wi-Fi signal.
- Check if the litter box is linked to another device. Hold the button on the device for 10s to reset or unbound the device on App.
- Check if a 5GHz Wi-Fi is used. Try a Personal hot spot, or change 5GHz to 4GHz to connect your mobile. Consult the router supplier for detailed instruction on router configuration.

Bin does not rotate or stops rotating suddenly.

- Disconnect from the power supply and remove the cover lid to check if there is any foreign object stuck at the gear of the bin.
- Make sure the bin is installed properly on the base. Reconnect it to the power supply and try again.
- The bin stops rotating automatically when cat or other unknown weight is detected. It will resume rotating after the cat leaves, or the weight is disappeared.

Troubleshooting

PROBLEM

SOLUTION

Indicator stays solid in red.

- Check if the cover lid and waste drawer are properly installed in place. You will hear one beep once properly installed.
- Check if the cat is approaching or enters the bin during cleaning or emptying. It will resume cleaning or emptying after the cat leaves.

Indicator flashes in red quickly.

Disconnect from the power supply and remove the cover lid to check if there is any foreign object stuck at the gear of the bin.

Waste drawer is empty, while the App warns it is full by mistake.

Please clean the two infrared sensors located around the UV light by wipes. The guideline is indicated in the App, please check it or contact us directly.

How to turn on UV sterilization?

- The UV sterilization is available on App only. There are two modes of sterilization. Manual sterilization: Tap Sterilization on homepage to sterilize once (about 10min).
- Smart sterilization: Tap Set Up on homepage then enable Smart Sterilization. Sterilization auto starts once every 6 hours.

- Do not place the litter tray in areas exposed to moisture, direct sunlight or extreme temperatures, unless otherwise indicated in the operating instructions.

- Only use the litter tray for animals of the correct size and weight, as recommended by the manufacturer. Use of the litter tray by an animal that is too small or too large may cause discomfort or malfunction of the unit.
- Make sure the animal is comfortable using the litter tray - introduce the device gradually to avoid stress.
- If the unit malfunctions, switch it off immediately to avoid potential hazards to the animal, such as jamming in the moving mechanisms.

- For models with waste bags, replace them as needed to avoid waste accumulation.
